The RM of West Interlake declared a State of Local Emergency on June 10, 2026, under resolution #2026-209.

We continue working with our Emergency Management Consultant and the Preparedness and Response Branch | Emergency Management Organization, Manitoba Transportation and Infrastructure and Water Engineering & Operations, Engineering & Technical Services, Manitoba Transportation & Infrastructure.

Locally, the RM is still working within the Ashern LUD to alleviate sewer back ups and lift station flooding. The Boundary Line Drain and all municipal roads and ditches are being monitored by the RM Public Works and the Water Engineering & Operations, Engineering & Technical Services, Manitoba Transportation & Infrastructure.

As of June 16, 2026

The Public Works Department is opening a damaged culvert gate along Boundary Line drain, and another culvert through Stark Rd. The PW Department with the assistance of local volunteers are installing Tiger tubes at potential flood locations along Boundary Line drain. The PW is extending the temporary berm and increasing berm elevation along HWY 325 and Stark Rd. The RM is monitoring the Boundary Line drain at the Glencora culverts and working with the Water Engineering & Operations, Engineering & Technical Services, Manitoba Transportation & Infrastructure to potentially open the Boundary Line gates enough to relieve water build up.
